

CCF Children's Ministry COVID-19 Requirements

Dear Parents,

CCF Kids Ministry will reopen and resume classes beginning the weekend of Sept.6th for the Sunday 9:30 am service and for Wednesday evening at the 6:30 pm service **only** at this time. Parents wishing to keep their kids with them during the live service may continue to do so. You also can continue to watch virtually until you feel comfortable returning. There will be a few changes in our operation that we wanted to make you aware of and request your cooperation:

1. **You must be healthy to enter the building:** Please assist us by not coming to service sick or bringing sick children to the service. If in the past 7 days, you or your children have a cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, fever, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, or had a fever in the past 24 hours please do not come to the service. We will be monitoring our own volunteers to make sure they comply too.
2. **Parents and their kids who are over 2 years old are required** to wear face masks or face shields. Also volunteers will be required to wear face masks or shields. Parents please provide a water bottle for your child. Also no food of any kind will be allowed or given by us to your child while they are in class or in any activities.
3. **Wash hands and/or use hand sanitizer:** We will ask that you use hand sanitizer when entering and leaving the building.
4. **Maintain physical distancing:** We will only enter the kids building from the playground which will lead into the Kingdom Room (game room) where check in will be done. Fellowship with other families can be conducted outside the building. This will allow other parents space for others dropping off their kids.

Electronic Check-in: We are excited to announce we will be using Kidcheck for check-in and is easily done on your cell phone. **Due to the covid precautions we are highly encouraging everyone to sign in by cell phone.** This will also allow you to drop off your children much faster and easier. Parents please pick up your children from the Kingdom Room (Game Room) at the end of service. Please give your guardian tag to your child's teacher before leaving with your child.
